Members Highway Fund

As your two Divisional County Councillors, we have been busy continuing the business of County Council. We were delighted to fund the new village signs in all of our villages and new speed signs from our Members Highways Fund.







Flooding

As flooding has affected us this year, we are doing all we can to ensure issues are being raised at the highest level and that residents and businesses are aware of



and directed to the help available. The flooding issues on the A47 were finally addressed after major investigations were carried out on the drainage systems which included private drains. Now with some major drainage works and raising of footways, the problems have been addressed.

Casework

We were both involved in the controversial planning application in Glenfield for the loss of a much used car park for housing, which was successfully refused.



We continue to help residents with other matters, such as highways, trading standards, adult and children's social care matters and schooling issues.
